### **Dennis H. Treacy President, Smithfield Foundation**

Mr. Treacy is President of the Smithfield Foundation, the philanthropic arm of Smithfield Foods. The Smithfield Foundation provides educational scholarships to the dependent children and grandchildren of full-time and retired employees of Smithfield. In addition, the Foundation also helps fund educational partnerships, food security programs, environmental projects, animal well-being initiatives, university research, and local projects.

Previously, Mr. Treacy served as Executive Vice President and Chief Sustainability Officer for Smithfield Foods, where he directed many areas within the company, including government affairs, corporate communications, environmental programs, sustainability initiatives, and the legal department.

Mr. Treacy also serves or has served on dozens of state and national boards and commissions.

Prior to joining Smithfield Foods in 2002, he served as director of the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality. He also served as assistant attorney general in the natural resources section of the Virginia Attorney General's office. He is a 2010 "Distinguished Environmental Law Graduate" from Lewis & Clark Law School in Portland, Oregon, where he graduated in 1983. He completed his undergraduate degree in Forestry and Wildlife at Virginia Tech in 1978, and currently serves on its Board of Visitors.
